# **Vocab Review Dice**

- Students in groups of 3-5
- Recent vocabulary on cards, cut up in a pile in the middle of the group.

Here's how it works ...

Roll the dice:

1 or 2 – You explain the word (Keep the card hidden!)

3 or 4 – Table explains the word to you (Card on your forehead, no peeking!)

5 or 6 – Choose a "victim" in your group, make them spell the word!

# Vocabulary Whiteboards

#### How it works ...

- Put students in groups of 3-5
- Give each group a small whiteboard, marker and eraser
- Explain that you will give definitions of recent vocabulary, and that students must write the correct vocab (with correct spelling!) as quickly as possible
- Award points as follows: 1 point = correct word and spelling, bonus point = correct and fastest!
- New writer for each new vocab item, but whole team ca help
